Thunder Bay police investigate graffiti: 'I killed those kids'

Thunder Bay police are investigating an incident in which the words "I killed those kids" was written on an old VIA passenger rail car that is on display at the Kamview Overlook Park.

"As a result of the implications of this message, the Thunder Bay Police Criminal Investigations Branch started an investigation on June 8, 2017 into this matter," police said in a news release.

The TBPS Identification Unit attended the location and processed the scene for the documentation and collection of evidence, police said.

City of Thunder Bay workers have since removed the writing from the train.

Investigators have spoken to a witness in conjunction with this investigation, police added, in order to determine who might be responsible for it and what, if any, relevance it might have to outstanding investigations.
